The Map Collection of the Herder Institute (Marburg/Germany) offers scholarships for young researchers from Ukraine.

The scholarship

The Map Collection supports research on history and geography of Central and Eastern Europe. Your research may focus on topics like the shift of borders, the development of transport and communication networks, urban history, environmental changes, history of place names, map history etc.

The scholarship should allow young researchers to work on existing projects or to develop a new initiative, such as a PhD project. The map collection offers a scholarship of one or two months (with an amount of 1000,00 Euros per month). During the time period of the scholarship, the researcher is requested to stay in the Marburg area in order to use the library and collections of the Herder Institute.

Your qualification

You hold a masters degree (or an equivalent) in history, geography or in a neighbouring discipline. You are able to write academic texts in English or German.
